Sub: Mines & Minerals-Mining & Quarry Leases, Mineral Dealers, Temporary Permit holders etc-Fitment of High Security Registration Plates (HSRP) for all Mineral Carrying Vehicles Registered with the Department of Mines & Geology-Instructions issued-Regarding.

Ref: Word Order No.3385773/IT-DM&G/2025, Dt:07.01.2026 to Empaneled Agencies for ANPR Systems.

The attention of all the DDM&Gs and ADM&Gs in the State is drawn to the subject and reference cited. It has been observed that the identification and monitoring of mineral carrying vehicles operating from mining & quarry leases, mineral dealer units etc is getting affected due to the absence of standardized registration plates on the vehicles. This has resulted in difficulties in surveillance, enforcement, permit validation, and tracking of vehicles involved in mineral transportation.

In order to ensure transparent operations, effective monitoring, prevention of illegal transportation, and accurate vehicle identification, it has been decided to mandate the fitment of High Security Registration Plates(HSRP) to all vehicles registered with the Department of Mines & Geology, Govt. of Telangana.

1. This mandate applies to all mineral carrying vehicles including lorries, tippers, dumping tippers, tractors etc from leasehold areas, mineral dealer areas, temporary permit, stockyards etc.
2. All such vehicles must be fitted with High-Security Registration Plates (HSRP) on both front and rear, as prescribed by the Transport Department.
3. The responsibility for HSRP fitment and maintenance lies solely with the leaseholder, mineral dealer, vehicle owner/operator. Registration plates must remain clearly visible, intact and free from tampering or damage.
4. HSRP details will be verified at the permit issuance entry to leasehold areas, mineral dealer areas, temporary permit areas, stockyards etc and exit, using CCTV, ANPR, and other available monitoring systems.
5. Vehicles operating without HSRP or with damaged, tampered or fake plates are liable to be blocked in the ePermit online system. No further permits or dispatches will be allowed until full compliance.
6. In addition to blocking, Department may impose penalties as decided from time to time. Repeat violations will attract higher penalties, including temporary or permanent blacklisting of the vehicle or operator.
7. The contents of this Circular must be prominently displayed at all

leasehold areas, mineral dealer areas, temporary permit areas, communicated to all transporters, vehicle owners, and lorry unions, and treated as a mandatory condition for mineral carrying vehicles.

**Timeline:** *All mineral carrying vehicles including lorries, tippers, dumping tippers, tractors should install High Security Registration Plate (HSRP) within **one month (28.02.2026)** from the date of this circular.*

In view of the above, the DDM&Gs and ADM&Gs are directed to take-up awareness campaign to all the leasehold areas, mineral dealer areas, temporary permit areas, all transporters, vehicle owners and lorry unions etc and strict instructions be issued to all field staff to ensure absolute compliance without any deviation.
